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*) **The insulating glass unit manufacturer** is defined as the party producing or attempting to produce insulating glass units in accordance with the Quality and Inspection Regulations, has the necessary expertise and accepts the Statutes as binding.

*) **The component manufacturer** is the party supplying the product to the insulating glass unit manufacturer under his own product name. If there are cases in which suppliers act as "manufacturers" but do not produce the product themselves, the following applies:

- The supplier (= "manufacturer") is responsible for the consistent quality of the product (private label regulation between producer and supplier). If an internal inspection (incoming goods control at the supplier's premises) is not possible, a batch-specific manufacturer test report must be prepared by the producer.
- The supplier (= "manufacturer") does not have to provide their own Technical Documentation, but must own and make available the producer's Technical Documentation with a written permission for use. This Technical Documentation must not be older than 3 years at the time of granting the permission of use and must have been continuously confirmed during this 3-year period within the scope of component monitoring. This permission of use also shows the trade name under which the specific product is distributed. Alternatively, the supplier can also provide their own technical documentation.
- Inspection of consistent quality is carried out for each manufacturer (as defined above) and product name.
